Directory information includes: name, semester (local) and permanent address, NetID, email address (university-supplied), telephone number, classification, most recent previous educational institution attended, graduate or undergraduate level, full-time or part-time status, college, major, dates of attendance, degrees and awards, participation in school activities and sports, weight and height.
